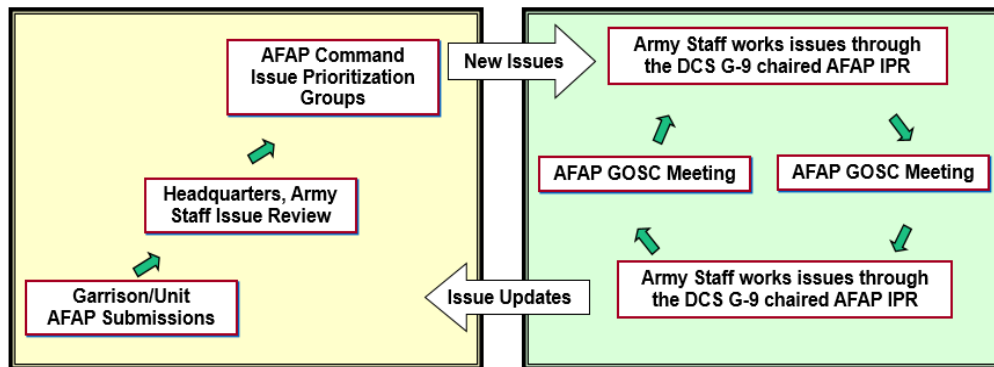
The AFAP is a grass-roots process developed in **1983** through a ground-breaking white paper on the importance of increasing support to the Army Family, written by then Chief of Staff of the Army Gen. John A. Wickham Jr.,



The AFAP process (operating at three distinct levels - garrison/tenant unit, select Army Commands and HQDA) provides a mechanism for Army's global force to identify quality of life issues that impact the Total Army Family.

AFAP Accomplishments

- Since 1983, 761 issues have entered AFAP
 - 554 issues resolved; 170 issues closed as unattainable
 - **Currently working 37 Active AFAP issues**
- Driving force behind the enactment of:
 - 130 pieces of legislation
 - 200 policy changes
 - 223 improved programs and services

Army-centric with 60% of issues impacting all services
