Soldier alleges his CoC is violating Soldier's profile by making him attend a behavior health evaluation, and a drug rehabilitation program. Soldier alleges Chain of Command (CoC) is insensitive to medical needs.

Soldier states he feels he should not get an ART 15 because the new medication caused him to over sleep and also, the fact that he informed his CoC of his sleep problem

The SM agreed to this counseling and said this was more appropriate and he had no problems complying with the POA.
