## DECOMMISSIONING ZONE

### A ONE-STOP-SHOP FOR DECOMMISSIONING RESOURCES



**The Decommissioning Zone is a one-stop-shop for all stakeholders to access the decommissioning resources and gain insight into the stages, checklists, and dependencies of decommissioning.**

The tools and dashboards in the Decommissioning Zone (Decom Zone) allows headquarters staff and personnel at hospitals and clinics access to resources that enable the safe decommissioning of legacy information technology (IT) systems being replaced by MHS GENESIS. The Electronic Health Record Modernization (EHR Mod) Branch coordinates efforts with Solution Delivery Division (SDD) legacy IT system program managers (PMs) and military hospitals and clinics points of contact to ensure all steps are in place prior to decommissioning. The Decom Zone features frequently asked questions from all MHS GENESIS sites that have previously gone through the legacy system decommissioning activities along with quick links to helpful documents and resources.

### Background

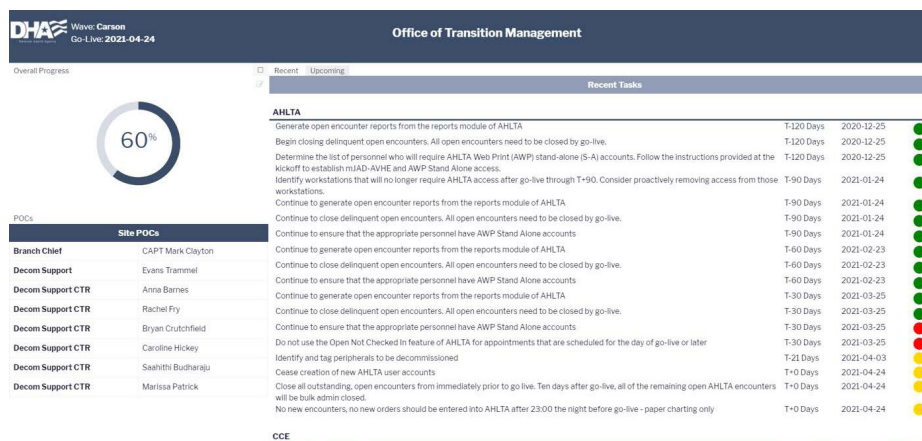
The Site Progress Report allows SDD leadership and system program managers to track a site's progress of completing the decommissioning checklist. All updates made through the Site Decommissioning Checklist are displayed on the report.

### Key Benefits

- ▶ Helps leadership and military hospital and clinic staff track progress towards completion
- ▶ Keeps military hospital and clinic staff informed with answers to common questions and solutions to obstacles encountered at other military hospitals and clinics
- ▶ Highlights data dependences that may delay decommissioning progress if not resolved

- ▶ Frequently asked questions section with answers to common questions from military hospitals and clinics that have previously gone through the decommissioning process
- ▶ Dashboards for assessing progress and tracking tasks
